Use guidelines based on the program level of the youngest girl in the group when considering group activities. If a reference page is given for *Safety-Wise* you must read the entire Activity Checkpoint for all relevant information.

Inflatable's such as ball bounces, slides or moonwalks	All levels	Appropriate adult supervision must be provided at all time when inflated.
Portable Climbing Wall <i>*(pgs. 99 – 101)</i>	JR CD SR AM	
Rifle/gun safety <i>*(pg. 80)</i>	Restricted	Age 12 & above – must have prior written approval from council and parents
Snowboarding/tubing <i>*(pg. 110)</i>	JR CD SR AM	
<b>Aquatic &amp; Water Related Activities</b>		
Blob <i>*(pgs. 112 – 114)</i>	JR CD SR AM	Must be comfortable swimming in deep water
Canoes <i>*(pgs. 115-116)</i>	BR JR CD SR AM	Non-swimmers must be paired with an adult
Kayaks <i>*(pgs. 117-118)</i>	JR CD SR AM	
Lake Swimming <i>*(pgs. 120 – 123)</i>	BR JR CD SR AM	Generally requires a swim test – girl must be comfortable swimming in water over her head
Paddleboats	BR JR CD SR AM	
Powerboat inner tube <i>*(pgs. 112-114)</i>	JR CD SR AM	Must be comfortable swimming in deep water
Scuba <i>*(pg. 123)</i>	Restricted	Age 12 & above
Swimming in pools <i>*(pgs.120-122)</i>	BR JR CD SR AM	Swim test required before 1 <sup>st</sup> swim
<b>ACTIVITIES NOT PERMITTED FOR PROGRAM <i>*(pg. 80)</i> AT ANY AGE LEVEL</b>		ATVs & motorbikes, bungee jumping, hang gliding, parasailing, hunting, parachuting, paintball, use of trampolines of any type.
