## Camp Timber Ridge CIT Information Packet



Dear Counselor-In-Training (CIT) Applicant,

Thank you for considering the CIT program at Camp Timber Ridge for the summer of 2010. Start planning now for some of the most exciting weeks of your life! To facilitate our staff in providing the best experience for our campers and CIT participants, CIT registration and confirmation is a three-part process.

### **PART ONE** Registering for Camp

CIT 1: June 13-25, 2010 or July 11-23, 2010 to be eligible for program must be entering 10<sup>th</sup> grade

CIT 2: June 13-25, 2010 or July 11-23, 2010 to be eligible for program must be entering 11<sup>th</sup> grade

Don't forget to register on line [www.gsgatl.org](http://www.gsgatl.org) on January 27, 2010 after 9 a.m. or send in your camper application post marked on or after January 27, 2010.

### **PART TWO** Completion of Paperwork

Please download and complete the following two forms and return them to me no later than January 30, 2010, the Girl Application for Leadership Project and the Girl and Parent/Guardian Agreement for Participation in Leadership Project. IN addition, ask your Girl Scout troop leader or another adult who knows you well (not a relative) to complete and return the reference form. The reference form should be returned to Camp Timber Ridge, no later than January 30, 2010.

### **PART THREE** Interview

During the interview we will discuss your interest in the program and conduct a group orientation session. The date of this interview is Sunday May 4<sup>th</sup> from 2-4pm. The first part of the interview will be a group format that includes the CIT's and prents, to be followed by an individual interview with each CIT.

### **What to expect:**

#### **CIT 1:**

- chance to bond and learn from peers
- chance to learn about campers in a variety ways from developmental stages too how to entertain them in all types of environments
- participate in leadership development activities
- Shadow and observe camp staff on all levels at all different times of day

#### **CIT 2:**

- spend 2 weeks interning in a camp
- 1 week with day camp
- 1 week with resident camp
- Will get to lead activities and participate in parts of the camp living unit
- Visit another camp and observe the differences in that camp community

We are very excited about the 2010 CIT program at Timber Ridge this summer.

Here are a few things you have to look forward:

- ◆ Learning great strategies for working with kids outdoors
- ◆ Gaining an insider's view of what the expectations are for a camp counselor and other camp positions
